We processes prescriptions for same day pickup from emergency room and urgent care centers. You can drop off properly issued/signed VA prescriptions into one of the pharmacy drop boxes located in parking lot and inside the lobby.

Patient Instructions: **Electronic prescriptions submitted by a doctor's office are not automatically ready for pick-up.** You must activate pre-prescriptions through **Q-Anywhere**, or by filling out an activation request slip located at the Urgent Care Pharmacy.

Once activated, prescriptions will be ready for pick up at the drive thru in 2 duty days (exception: special order medications will take 5 duty days). To activate prescriptions:

You must call all refills into the automated refill line at:

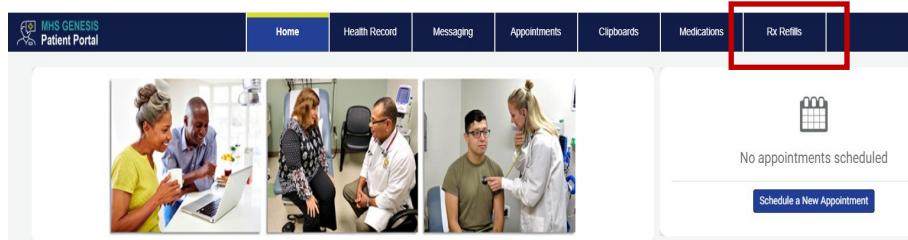

Utilize the '**Rx Refill**' tab on the MHS Genesis Patient Portal.



- Refills will be available for pick-up after 8 a.m. in three duty days (as applicable based on mission needs) at the Drive-Thru Pharmacy.
 - Patients may order refills before their prescription runs out:
 - 30 day supply - 7 days prior
 - 90 day supply - 22 days prior
- Patients have **10 calendar days** from the pick-up date to pick up prescriptions or they will be returned to stock.
- If picking up controlled items, you must present the patient's valid military issued ID (CAC or DOD ID CARD) or a picture of the patient's DOD ID (front & back) on your mobile device.

Additional Information

All pharmacies will be closed on Federal Holidays.

Training Day Schedule: Every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month, the Main Pharmacy, Sabal Park, and Urgent Care pharmacies will have a delayed opening of 1 p.m. The drive thru pharmacy will be open for **pick up only** starting at 10 a.m.

Dates and times subject to change

Prior Authorization: This is pre-approval for special order medications required by TRICARE before a *specific* prescription drug is covered by your plan. Your doctor's office needs to complete the prior authorization process before the pharmacy can process the prescription. The quickest way for your doctor's office to get a prior authorization from TRICARE is by calling the 'TRICARE Prior Authorization' line at:

Prescription Transfers

- *FROM A MILITARY INSTALLATION WITH MHS GENESIS:* Call the MacDill refill line and enter the prescription number on the label. It will automatically feed into our system.
- *FROM A RETAIL PHARMACY:* MacDill AFB Pharmacy will not transfer **in** from a retail pharmacy. Patients must have their doctor electronically send a new prescription to the base pharmacy and then the patient must activate.
- MacDill AFB Pharmacy will transfer active refills **out** to any military or retail pharmacy. Have the new pharmacy call 813-827-7910, option 3 and leave a message. We complete outgoing transfers within 24 hours.

WE NOW OFFER A NEW WAY TO LEARN ABOUT YOUR MEDICATIONS!

By scanning the QR code on your prescription you can now:

- 1 Locate the QR code on your prescription label.
- 2 Open the iPhone camera, Google camera, or any other QR code reader and hold the camera 6 inches above the QR code to scan.
- 3 Click the drop down link to watch a short video and see other information

Read the information sheet normally printed on paper by pressing the "inform me" button.



View a high quality image of your medication located in the "menu" button.

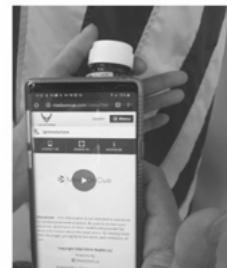
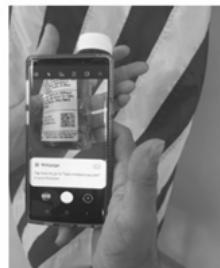
SCAN YOUR PRESCRIPTION LABEL FOR DRUG INFORMATION
